**THE APPOINTMENT OF SENATOR THE HONOURABLE REGINALD T.A. ARMOUR SC AS ATTORNEY GENERAL AND MINISTER OF LEGAL AFFAIRS OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO.**

The Office of the Attorney General and Ministry of Legal Affairs (AGLA) wishes to advise that Mr. Reginald T.A. Armour SC has been appointed as Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs, effective March 16, 2022.

Mr. Armour SC is an Attorney at Law specializing as an Advocate in the areas of Commercial Law, Labour Relations Constitutional and Public Law and Fraud and maintains a wide Caribbean Legal activism. He was appointed a Senior Counsel by the President of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago in 2003 and debated before the Caribbean Court of Justice, the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council and, Courts of Appeal and High Courts across the Caribbean.

Mr. Armour served as President of the Law Association of Trinidad & Tobago from 2015 to 2017 and as a Court of Appeal Judge of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court and acted as a High Court Judge of the Supreme Court of Trinidad & Tobago. He is a former member of the Law Reform Commission and the Legal Aid Authority of Trinidad and Tobago.

Mr. Armour was appointed by the President of the Republic of Trinidad & Tobago to serve as Tribunal Counsel to the 2007 Lord Michael Mustill Tribunal.

Moreover, in 2012 Mr. Armour was appointed by the Chief Justice of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court as Tribunal Counsel to the Stollmeyer Tribunal, sitting in St. Lucia, which were both constitutional Tribunals established to investigate and report on judicial misbehaviour.

AGLA would like to recognize the achievements of the outgoing Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs the Honourable Faris Al-Rawi M.P. for his invaluable contribution in significantly changing the legal landscape of Trinidad and Tobago in the form of plant, machinery, processes and the law.

AGLA welcomes Senator the Honourable Reginald T.A. Armour SC to his new role and looks forward to partnering with him in keeping watch and continuing to be guardians of the public's interest.
