<u>UNSC ISIL (DA'ESH) AND AL-QAIDA SANCTIONS LIST</u> <u>- DELISTING OF ONE (1) INDIVIDUAL</u>

Members of the Public are advised that the United Nations Security Council ISIL (Da'esh) and AI-Qaida Sanctions Committee has **removed an individual from the ISIL (Da'esh) and AI-Qaida Sanctions List.**

Members of the public are advised that competent authorities of Trinidad and Tobago in keeping with its legislative and international obligations also took similar action. The following actions have been taken:

i. High Court Order CV 2016-03992 has been partially revoked.

The partial revocation of the aforementioned Court Order has the following effect:

- i. The individual named therein, Khalifa Muhammad Turki Al-Subaiy is no longer a listed entity pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07; and
- ii. His funds are no longer frozen.

In light of the foregoing, there are no longer restrictions on transactions involving the property of the aforementioned individual.

You are reminded that the provision of financial and/or any other related services, property and/or support to any continuing "*listed entity*" is an offence pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07 in Trinidad and Tobago.
