UNSC ISIL (DA'ESH) AND AL-QAIDA SANCTIONS LIST - DELISTING OF ONE (1) INDIVIDUAL

Members of the Public are advised that the United Nations Security Council ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee has **removed one (1) individual from the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List.**

Members of the public are advised that competent authorities of Trinidad and Tobago in keeping with its legislative and international obligations also took similar action. The following action has been taken:

High Court Order CV 2016-03973 has been amended.

The amendment of the aforementioned Court Order has the following effect:

- The one (1) individual named therein, Lionel Dumont is no longer a listed entity pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07; and
- The funds are no longer frozen.

In light of the foregoing, there are no longer restrictions on transactions involving the property of the aforementioned individual.

You are reminded that the provision of financial and/or any other related services, property and/or support to any continuing "*listed entity*" is an offence pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07 in Trinidad and Tobago.
