LISTING OF SHANE CRAWFORD UNDER THE UNITED NATIONS 1267 ISIL (DA'ESH) & AL-QAIDA SANCTIONS LIST

Members of the Public are advised that the United Nations Security Council has established a Committee referred to as the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee in accordance with United Nations Security Council Resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh), Al-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities. This Committee maintains a list of persons and entities against whom targeted financial sanctions are applied by the United Nations and Member countries ("the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List").

Pursuant to a listing proposal submitted to the Committee by the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, one Shane Dominic Crawford, a Trinidad and Tobago National, was listed as an individual in the United Nations 1267 ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List on August 18, 2017.

Should Shane Dominic Crawford wish to be removed from the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List, he or a representative may submit such representations to the Attorney General via the following contact information:
