UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2653 SANCTIONS LIST- LISTING OF TWO (2) INDIVIDUALS

Members of the Public are advised that the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) 2653(2022) Sanctions Committee added **two (2) entries** to the UNSC 2653(2022) Sanctions List.

Members of the public are advised that competent authorities of Trinidad and Tobago in keeping with its legislative and international obligations also took similar action. The following High Court Orders have been granted:

CV2025-02962 designating **GRAN GRIF** which is listed under the rubric ‘**HTe.001**’ on the United Nations Security Council 2653 Sanctions List;

CV2025-02963 designating **VIV ANSANM** which is listed under the rubric ‘**HTe.002**’ on the United Nations Security Council 2653 Sanctions List.

The effect of the aforementioned Orders are as follows:

- i. The entities named therein are listed entities pursuant to the Economic Sanctions (Implementation of United Nations Security Council Resolution 2653 (2022) on the Republic of Haiti) Order, 2023; and
- ii. The entities’ funds are frozen.

In light of the foregoing, there are restrictions on transactions involving the property of the aforesaid entities.
