Pursuant to Section 22B (5) of the Act, the Attorney General shall within seven (7) days after the date of this Order, cause a copy of the Order and a statement that the matter will be reviewed every six (6) months, to be published in the Gazette and in two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in Trinidad and Tobago.
