UNSC ISIL (DA'ESH) AND AL-QAIDA SANCTIONS LIST - DELISTING OF TWO (2) INDIVIDUALS

Members of the Public are advised that the United Nations Security Council ISIL (Da'esh) and AI-Qaida Sanctions Committee has **removed two (2) individuals from the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List.**

Members of the public are advised that competent authorities of Trinidad and Tobago in keeping with its legislative and international obligations also took similar action. The following action has been taken:

High Court Orders CV2016- 03986 and CV2017-01002 have been partially revoked.

The partial revocation of the aforementioned Court Orders have the following effect:

- i. The individuals named therein, (i) **ABD AL-MALIK** also known as **MUHAMMAD** also known as **YUSUF** also known as **UTHMAN** also known as **ABD AL-SALAM** and (ii) **NAYIF** also known as **SALIH** also known as **SALIM** also known as **AL-QAYSI** are no longer listed individuals pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07; and
- ii. Their funds are no longer frozen.

In light of the foregoing, there are no longer restrictions on transactions involving the property of the aforementioned individual.

You are reminded that the provision of financial and/or any other related services, property and/or support to any continuing "*listed entity*" is an offence pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07 in Trinidad and Tobago.
