UN ISIL (DA'ESH) AND AL-QAIDA SANCTIONS LIST — DE-LISTING PROCEDURE

Members of the Public are advised that the United Nations Security Council has established a Committee referred to as the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee in accordance with United Nations Security Council Resolutions 1267(1999), 1989(2011) and 2253(2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh), Al-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities. This Committee maintains a list of persons and entities against whom targeted financial sanctions are applied by the United Nations and Member countries ("the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List").

Members of the Public are advised that where an entity or individual (including a Trinidadian and Tobagonian entity or individual) has been placed on the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List, they may apply to the United Nations Office of the Ombudsperson to petition for removal from the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List.
