<u>UNSC ISIL (DA'ESH) AND AL-QAIDA SANCTIONS LIST</u> <u>- LISTING OF ONE (1) ENTITY</u>

Members of the Public are advised that the United Nations Security Council ISIL (Da'esh) and AI-Qaida Sanctions Committee has added one (1) entity to the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List.

Members of the public are advised that competent authorities of Trinidad and Tobago in keeping with its legislative and international obligations also took similar action. High Court Order CV2023-00266 has been granted designating Islamic State In Iraq And the Levant In South-East Asia (ISIL-SEA, ISIL-South East Asia) also known as Islamic State East Asia Division also known as Dawlatul Islamiyah Waliyatul Mashriq referred to as QDe.169 on the UN Sanctions List. The effect of the Order granted is as follows:

- i. The entity named therein is a listed entity pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07; and
- ii. The funds are frozen.

In light of the foregoing there are restrictions on transactions involving the property of this entity.

You are reminded that the provision of financial and/or any other related services, property and/or support to any continuing "listed entity" is an offence pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07 in Trinidad and Tobago.
